Writing Competition Rules ~ SENIOR SCHOOLS

Chalfont St Giles and Jordans Literary Festival 2008

All entries to be based on ONE of the three following Milton themes:

1. *All hell broke loose.*
2. *Every cloud has a silver lining.*
3. *Trip on the light fantastic.*

The categories for entry are :

Prose ~ Fiction or non-fiction, maximum 1000 words

Poetry ~ Maximum 30 lines of verse

Drama ~ Three characters per script maximum, 10 min maximum length

Age Categories : 11 – 14 years *and* 15 – 18 years (age on 04/04/08)

Cost : FREE - unlimited entries per person

- Entries should preferably be typed, on white A4 paper, at least size 12 font (fancy fonts should be avoided).
 - Hand written scripts should be written in black or blue ink in a legible hand, on wide ruled white A4 paper only.
 - Typed Prose entries must be double spaced, typed Poetry and Drama entries must be at least 1.5 line spaced.
 - There should be no illustrations of any kind on the manuscript.
 - The pages of each entry should be numbered and should be stapled with a single staple at the top left-hand corner.
 - No names or personal details to be written on the entered scripts, the title of the piece should appear on the top of EVERY page of the entry.
 - Previously unpublished work to be entered only. The Committee reserves the right to publish any entry.
 - Each entry must have a correctly completed entry form attached securely to the front of it.
 - If you are leaving your entry at the Library, the envelope should be clearly marked on the outside with the following information:

 - Please enclose a large SAE if entries are to be returned.
 - The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
 - **Any entries which fail to follow these guidelines will be automatically disqualified.**
